Boswell has had a distinguished career, serving over 20 years in Air Force and Joint Operational Combat Units. He commanded two Combat Wings and served as the Deputy Commander for the Department of Defense's only Joint Region Command in the Pacific Area of Responsibility.

With over 4,800 hours of flight time in the B-1B, B-52H, RC-135, and E-6B; and over 500 hours of combat time in Southwest Asia, the Horn of Africa, and the Balkans, his military experience is diverse. He has shared the experience of many of the Special Operations Veterans the Foundation supports and understands the value our programs offer the Special Operations community.
